

Junior Camps (3-4yo):

- **Terms and Conditions**

1. Payment is regarded as acceptance of the booking conditions.
2. Children must be aged between 3 and 4 years of age to be eligible to attend our Junior Camps.
3. Please note that only additional siblings from the same family can avail of the reduced rate. The reduced rate for siblings applies only where both children are attending the **same camp** (e.g. both attending Junior Camp). If one child attends Junior Camp and another attends Senior Camp, the full rate applies to each child.
4. All parents/guardians must sign our **Online Injury Waiver Form** prior to their child's attendance at our camps. This is mandatory. One signed form is sufficient to cover all camps attended within the same calendar year. Failure to sign the waiver will result in the child being denied entry to the camp.
5. **Cancellations:** All cancellations are subject to forfeiture of a booking deposit per child. If full payment has been made, the balance of the fee will be refunded. Deposits are non-refundable and places are non-transferable.
6. Cancellations made within 7 days prior to the first day of camp are not entitled to any refund.
7. **Deposit Paid:** Remaining payment is required on the specified date communicated to you following payment of the deposit. Failure to complete payment by this date may result in the child being omitted from the camp, with the deposit forfeited.
8. Due to child safety regulations, parents/guardians are **not permitted to watch or participate** in the running of the camp.
9. Camp runs from **9:30am to 1:00pm** each day. The Underdog Games Ltd and its staff are responsible for the supervision, safety, and wellbeing of children **only during these hours** and are not responsible outside of these times.
10. Any participant whose conduct is deemed by the Camp Manager to be detrimental to the best interests of the program, including the wellbeing of staff, other children, or themselves, will be dismissed. No refund will be made. Parents/guardians will be contacted by phone and the child will be removed from activities until collected.
11. The Underdog Games Ltd reserves the right to refuse admission to, or continued participation of, any child for any **reasonable reason relating to safety, wellbeing, or the effective operation of the camp**.
12. Children must comply with all safety instructions given by camp staff. Failure to do so may result in the child being removed from the activity or, where necessary, dismissed from the camp.
13. All allergies, medical conditions, or additional needs of children attending the camp **must** be fully and accurately disclosed on the Application Form. Failure to do so may result in immediate dismissal from the camp and/or exclusion from future camps.
14. The Underdog Games Ltd reserves the right to cancel a camp or amend camp dates or locations due to unforeseen circumstances.
15. Participation in camp activities is subject to the **Injury Waiver Form** signed by parents/guardians. Liability, where any arises, shall be determined in accordance with that waiver and applicable Irish law. Participation in physical activities involves inherent risk. The Underdog Games Ltd operates all activities with health and safety as a priority and holds full public liability insurance for activities undertaken. Personal Accident Insurance for injury, accident, or loss while attending camp remains the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
16. The camp accepts no responsibility for items lost, stolen, or damaged on the premises. Children are strongly advised not

to bring valuables to camp.

17. The camp does not guarantee the return of lost property. Parents/guardians should ensure that all belongings are collected at the end of each day.
18. The Underdog Games Ltd reserves the right to modify the program of activities where necessary due to unforeseen circumstances.
19. **Phones and Devices:** All digital devices (excluding smart watches) are prohibited during camp hours. Any device brought to camp must be switched off and kept in the child's bag until departure.
20. Photographs and video footage may be taken for promotional purposes. Parents/guardians who do not wish for their child to be photographed or recorded must notify staff prior to the first day of camp.
21. Places are allocated on a **first-come, first-served** basis.
